Dear Chairman Cole and Ranking Member DeLauro:

I am requesting funding for Creech AFB – Mission Support Facility in Fiscal Year 2027. The entity to receive funding for this project is Creech Air Force Base, located at Indian Springs, NV 89018. The funding would be used for the construction of a Mission Support Facility at Creech Air Force Base (Creech AFB). The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because currently, inadequate facilities adversely impact the ability of Creech AFB to support the needs of the Airmen and their family members stationed there. In many cases, Airmen must travel to Nellis Air Force Base, 50 miles away, to receive critical support service functions. This harms unit readiness and morale. The new Mission Support Facility would provide a permanent, consolidated facility for the 432d Mission Support Group (432 MSG) and 432d Support Squadron (432 SPTS) in support of mission and support services for all personnel on Creech AFB. The facility would also house many functions, including Group leadership, 432d Support Squadron Headquarters and Operations, Financial Management, Law Center, Military Personnel Flight, Airman and Family Readiness Center (A&FRC), and Education Center. The building would also provide a base-wide conference area, meeting space, and classrooms.

The project has a federal nexus because the funding provided is for purposes authorized by 10 U.S.C. Chapter 169 and the National Defense Authorization Act.
