I am requesting funding for Expanding Recovery Resources and Public Safety in Clark County in Fiscal Year 2027. The entity to receive funding for this project is Phoenix Multisport dba "The Phoenix," located at 3638 E Sunset Rd #110. Las Vegas, NV 89120. The funding would be used for enable The Phoenix to expand reentry and recovery services for individuals in Clark County, Nevada, with a focus on increasing programming at The Phoenix Community Center in Las Vegas and expanding digital recovery support across local correctional facilities. The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because the Community Center serves as a central reentry hub, providing peer-led fitness programs, support groups, and structured recovery programming for individuals transitioning back into the community. This project will also expand digital programming at Clark County Detention Center, North Las Vegas Community Correctional Center, and throughout the Nevada Department of Corrections network, ensuring continuity of care from incarceration through reintegration. With 83% of participants maintaining sobriety after engagement, this initiative will reduce recidivism, strengthen recovery outcomes, and improve public safety across Clark County.

The project has a federal nexus because the funding provided is for purposes authorized by section 501 of the Omnibus Crime Control and Safe Streets Act of 1968 (34 U.S.C. § 10152).
